CHAPTER 4

The Semantics of Words (2)

A- Homonyms

1- They are two or more words having different and unrelated meanings but the same spelling and /or the same pronunciation.

Examples:

خُفاش Bat خُفاش البيسبول مضرب

2- We have three types of Homonyms and they are:

A- Homographs OR (HETERONYMS)

They are words that have different meanings and different pronunciations but the same spelling.

Examples:

ما شيئاً يُمزِق Tear الدموع Tear

The word (Row) may mean:

- The number of people or things in a more or less straight line.
- A line of seats in a theater.
- To cause a boat to move through the water by pushing against the water with oars.
- B- Homophones: they are words that have different meanings and different spellings but the same pronunciation.

Examples:

 1- See الرؤية
 sea البحر

 2- Hear السمع
 here أمنا

 3- For لأجل four
 أولام

Another example: the words (two + to + too)

C- Third Type of Homonyms: Same Spelling / Same Pronunciation / Different Meaning

Examples:

1- Leaves اوراق الاشجار Leaves

2- Bar المكان الذي يتم فيه تقديم المشروبات bar

مصرف Bank ضفة النهر Bank

B- POLYSEMY

1- It is a word or phrase with multiple, related meanings.

Examples:

The word (Man)

- 1. The human species (i.e., man vs. other organisms)
- 2. Males of the human species (i.e., man vs. woman)
- 3. Adult males of the human species (i.e., man vs. boy)
- 4. (As a verb) to operate or constitute a vehicle or machine (To man a ship)

The word (Bank)

- 1. A financial institution
- 2. The physical building where a financial institution offers services
- 3. To deposit money or have an account in a bank (e.g. "I bank at the local credit union")

- 4. A supply of something held in reserve: such as "banking" brownie points
- 5. A synonym for 'rely upon' (e.g. "I'm your friend, you can bank on me").

C- Polysemy VS Homonymy

Polysemy	Homonymy
Definition: Polysemy is the existence of many possible meanings for a word or phrase.	Definition: Homonymy is the existence of two or more words having the same spelling or pronunciation but different meanings and origins.
Meanings: Polysemy has different, yet related meanings.	Meanings: Homonymy has completely different meanings.
Origins: Polysemy has related word origins	Origins: Homonymy has different origins.
Dictionaries: polysemous words are listed under one entry in dictionaries.	Dictionaries: homonymous words are listed separately.
Guessing the Meaning: polysemous words can be understood if you know the meaning of one word.	Guessing the Meaning: the meaning of homonymous words cannot be guessed since the words have unrelated meanings.
